The Wisconsin Risk and Reach Project provides a visual map and information about community risk factors and the reach of publicly funded programs designed to support children and families in all Wisconsin counties and tribal nations. The information and tools available here can be used to assess potential gaps in services by county and across the state. The county is assessed on community risk factors and the reach of publicly funded programs designed to support children and families. Each county is also assigned an “overall risk” score. This cumulative risk value is the average score of all indicators relative to other counties.
