Data Available	Description
All Births	Variety of details on births in Wisconsin, including number of births and information about fertility, pregnancy, the infant, the mother, their health, and their care.
Behavioral Risk Factor Survey	Measures behavioral risk factors, health conditions, health screening, and demographics of survey respondents
Cancer	Data on cancer incidence, incidence by stage, breast cancer incidence by stage, and cancer mortality rates.
Fertility	Birth rates in Wisconsin
Infant Mortality	Infant mortality rates and other measures of infant mortality
Injury-Related Health Outcomes	Includes injury-related mortality, emergency room visits, hospitalizations, and non-fatal motor vehicle crashes.
Low birthweight	A variety of measures and standards relating specifically to low birthweight.
Mortality	Cause of death categories, number of deaths, rate of mortality, age at death.
Opioids	Hospital encounters, drug overdose deaths, ambulance runs, naloxone distribution, opioid prescriptions, mortality rates.
Population	Statewide and regional population estimates by age and gender. Demographic summary of Hispanic population.
Prenatal Care	First trimester prenatal care information.
Teen Births	Charts on annual teen birthrate.
Violent Death	Homicide and suicide rates
