Approval of Minutes from November 20, 2019 Meeting

Ballweg moved to approve the November 20, 2019 minutes and Ullsvik seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Legislation Monitoring

The committee discussed the following items:

- Billings provided an update on the Safe Harbor Bill. Billings moved to change the Prevention Board's position to "information only" so it could provide more education if needed and Ullsvik seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Adoption Task Force bills. Moelter and Perez-Reyes updated the committee on the substitute amendments to the bills. The committee agreed to keep AB 559, 562, 565, and 566 in monitor status.
- LRB-1181 GAL appointments in nonparental visitation cases. This draft bill was circulated on December 17. The committee decided it was beyond the scope of the Prevention Board's work so it will not be added to the tracking document.
- LRB 2350 Shackling of children in the Youth Justice/Criminal Justice Systems. The draft bill was
 circulated on December 16 and related bills will likely be circulated soon. The committee decided this
 bill and the related bills are beyond the scope of the Prevention Board's work so they will not be
 added to the tracking document unless some provision is more directly related to prevention of child
 abuse and neglect.
