

## Community Opportunity Map

The Community Opportunity Map is an interactive tool from Casey Family Programs to highlight community level indicators designed to increase access to available information about communities, specifically drawing attention to environmental and community indicators commonly associated with child maltreatment. Users can select geographic regions from the nation as a whole to individual states, to counties to tribal nations to communities of any size. The map also allows the user to select a custom area of the map and access data for that area. Indicators can also be disaggregated by race and ethnicity.
